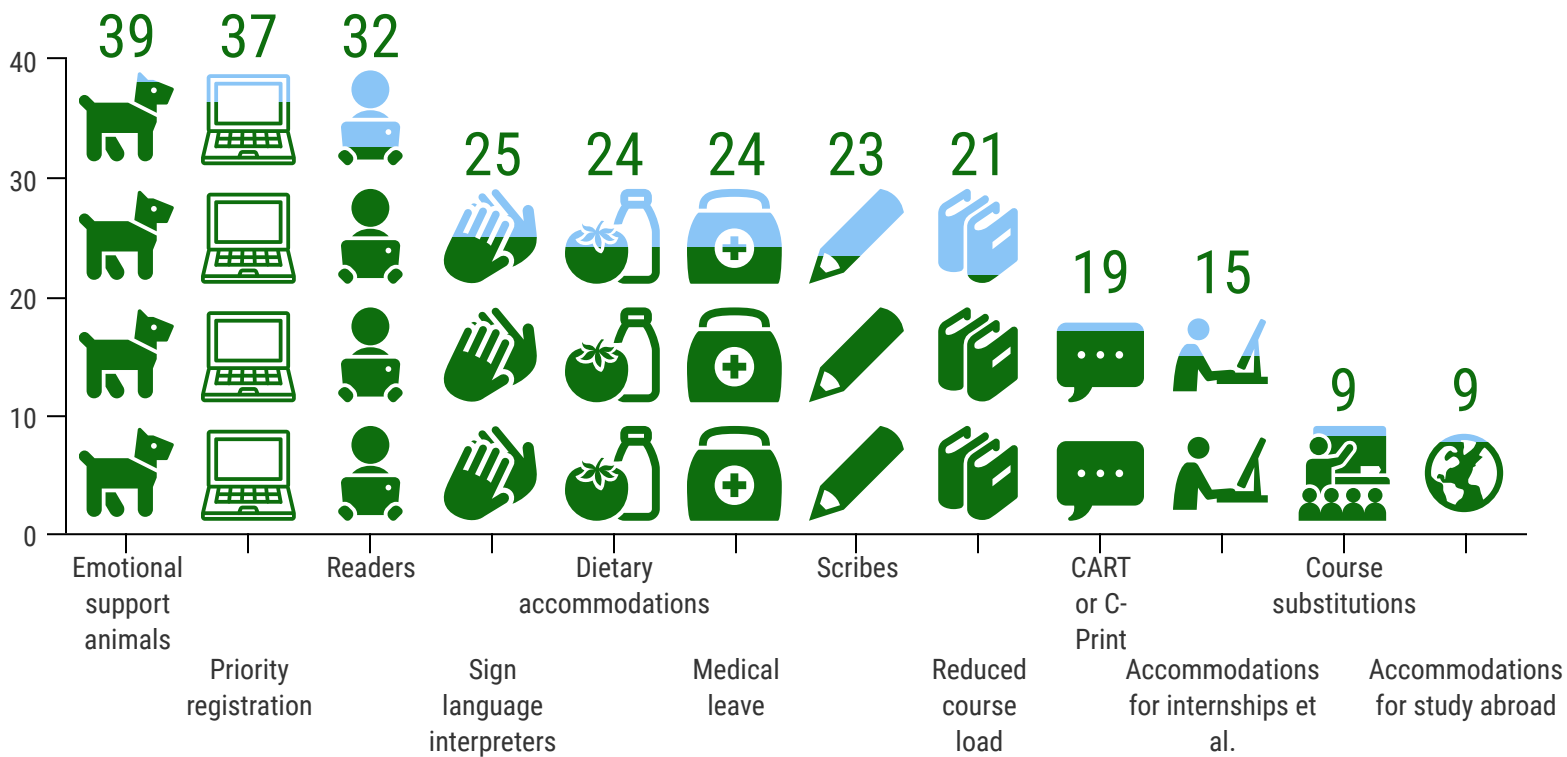
Campus representatives from 740 colleges and universities responded to this question:
